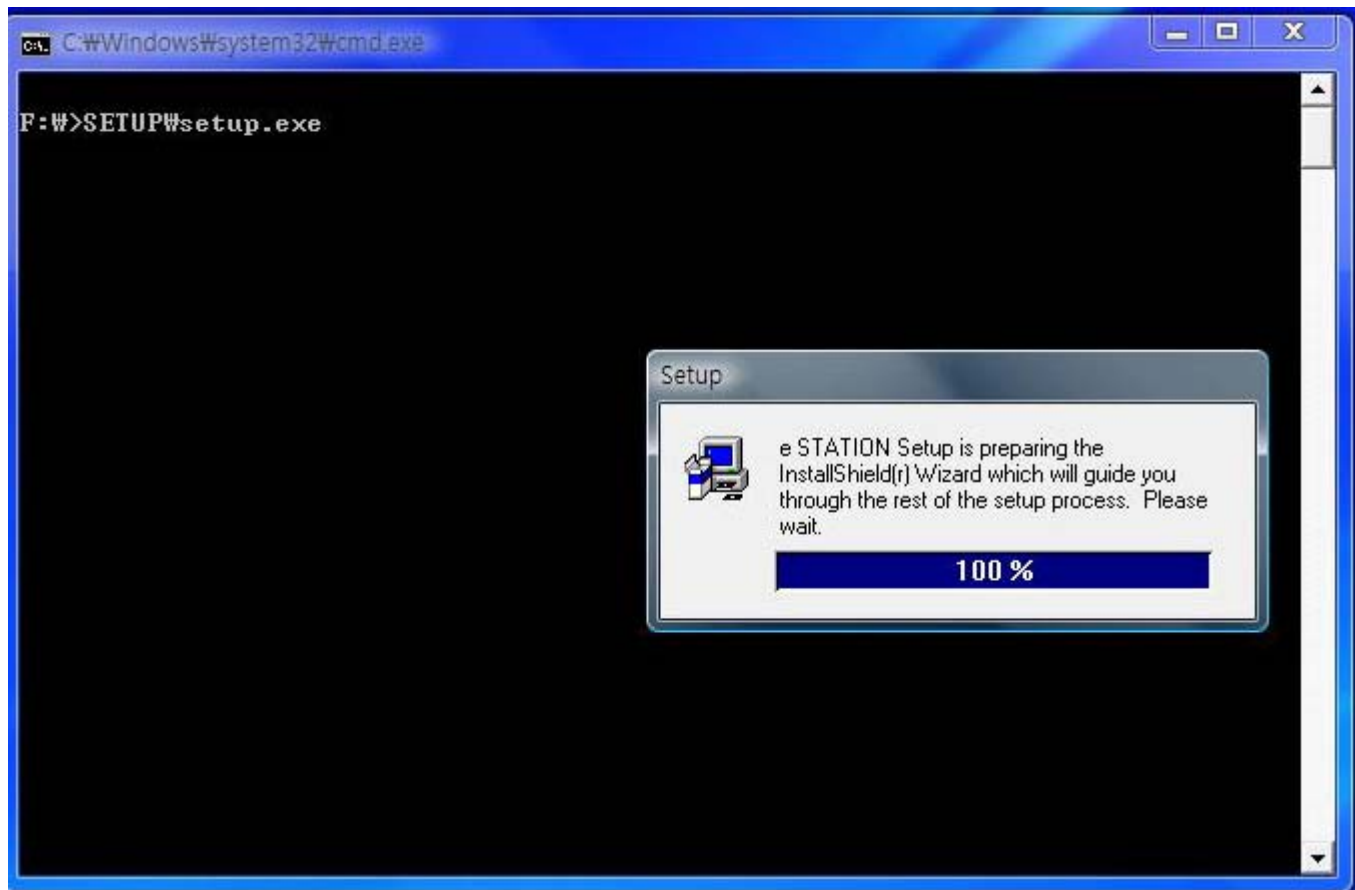
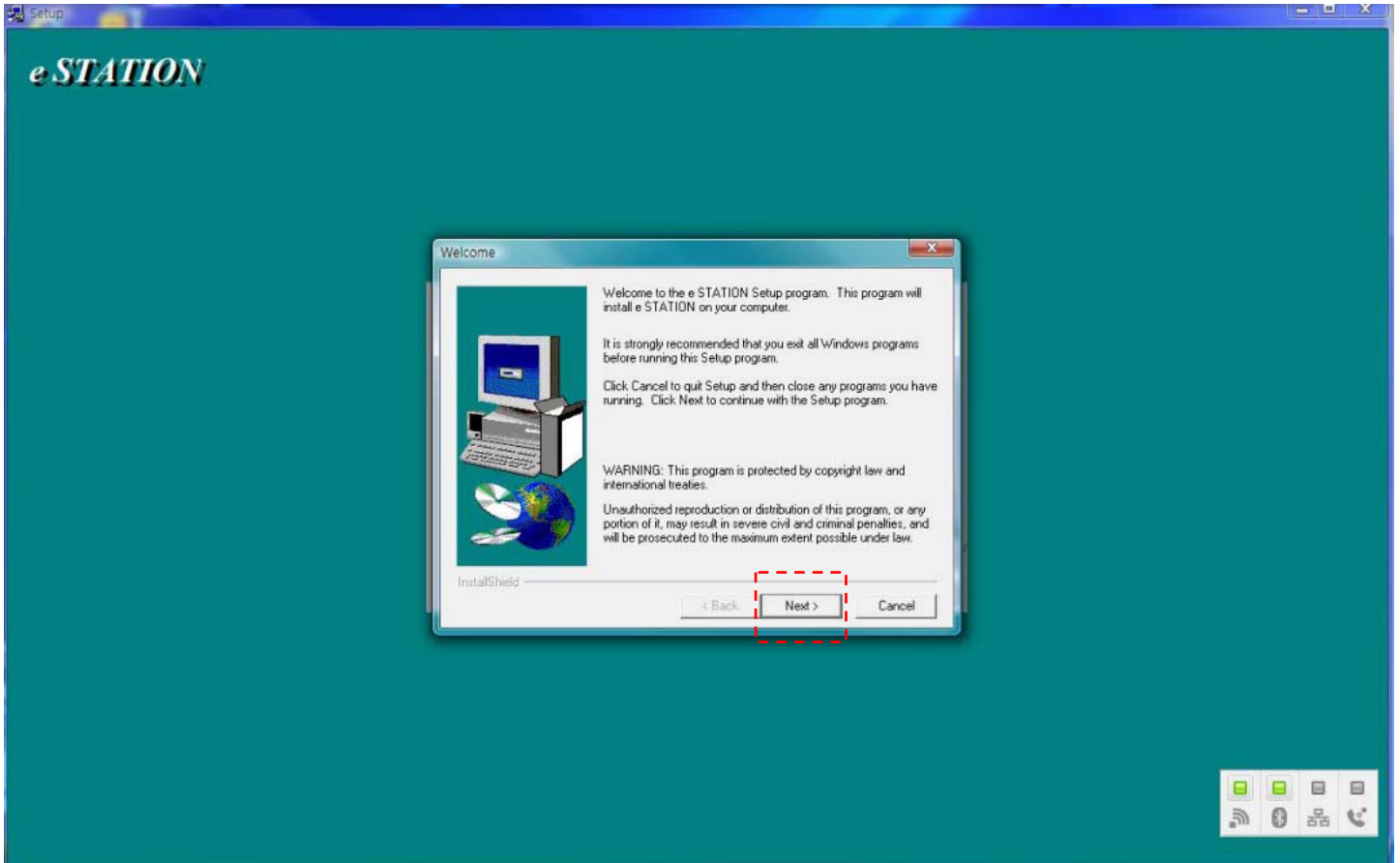

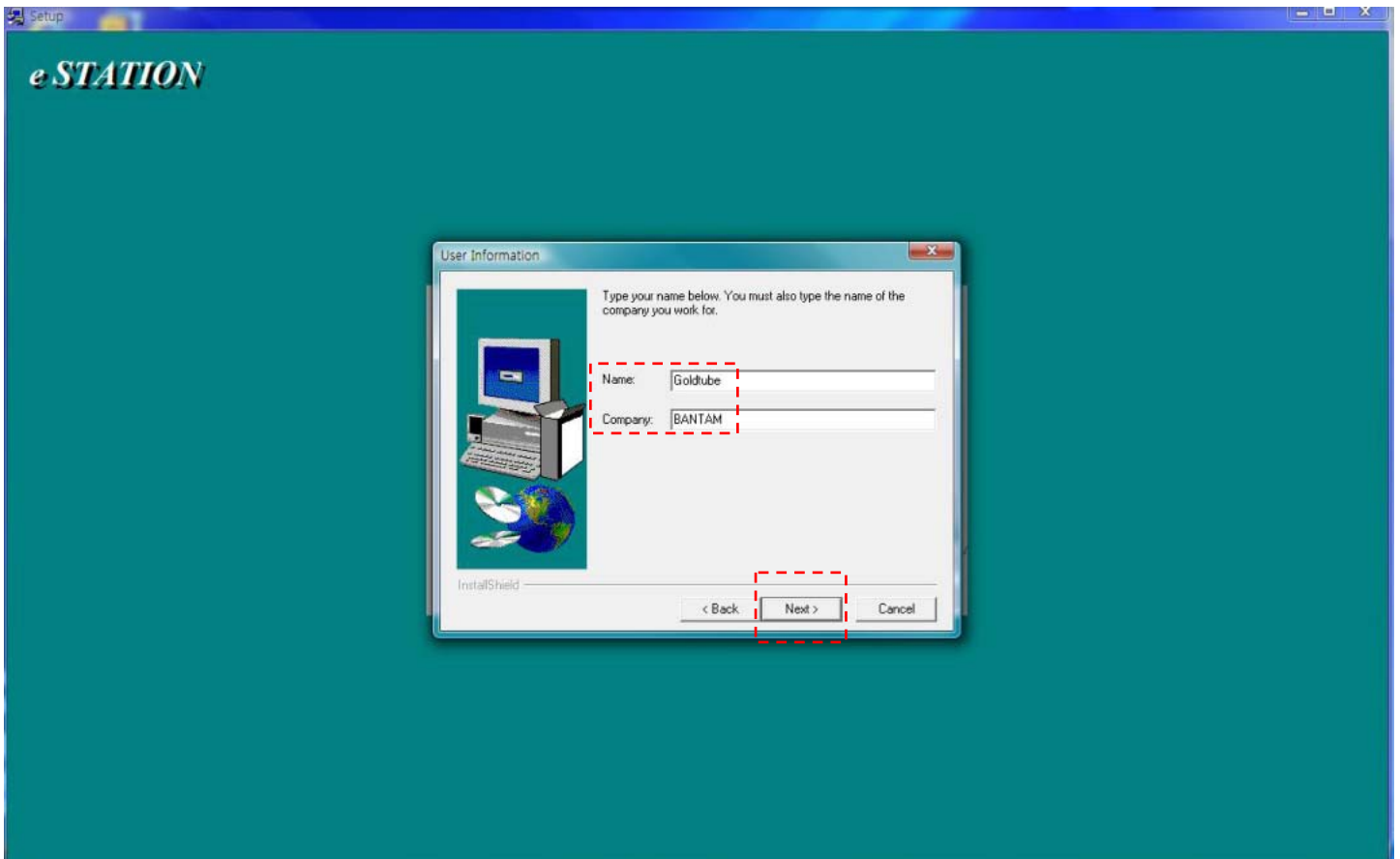
1. Installation will start automatically, when CD is inserted. Or, you can run 'SETUP\setup.exe' manually.



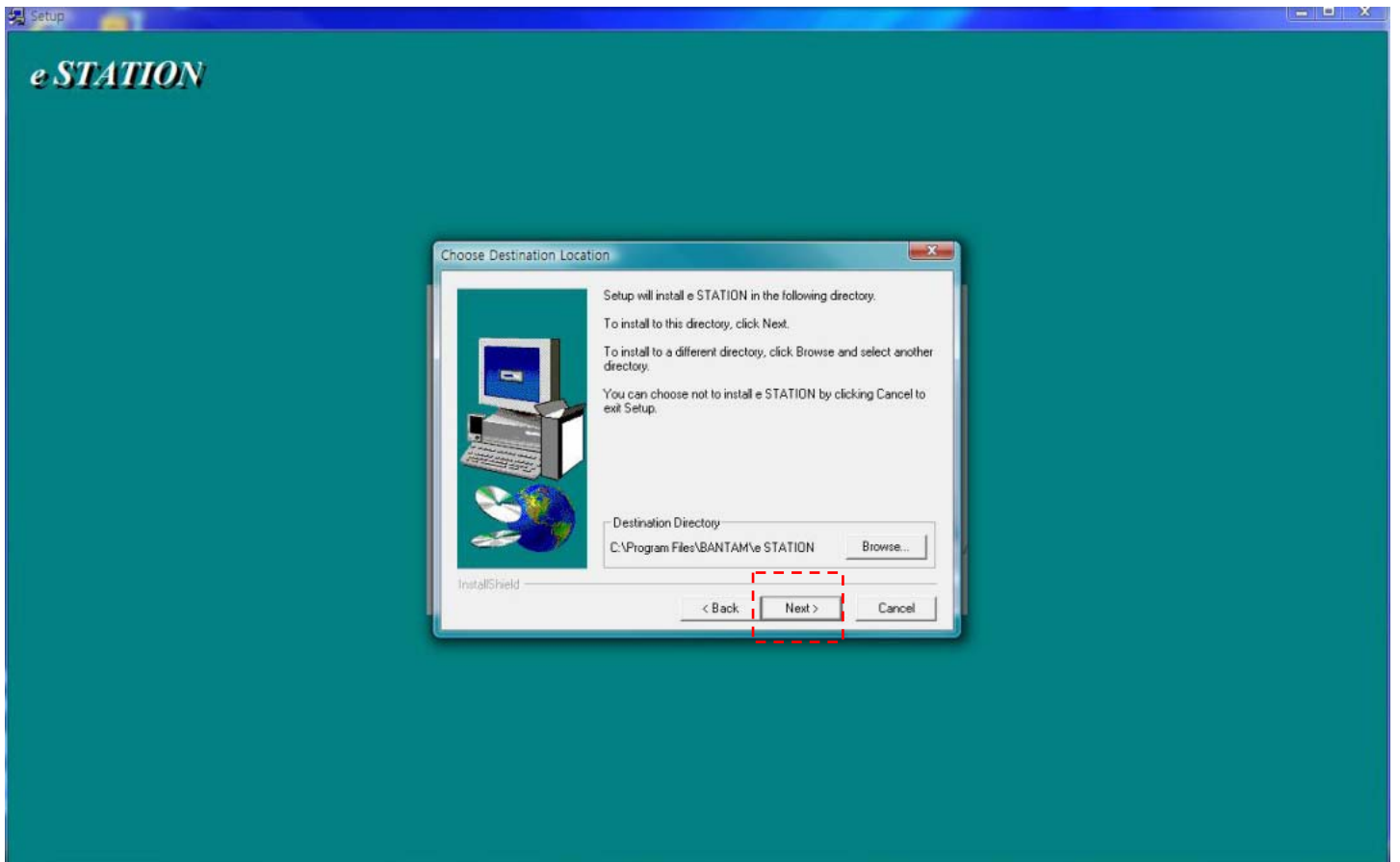
2. Click 'Next'



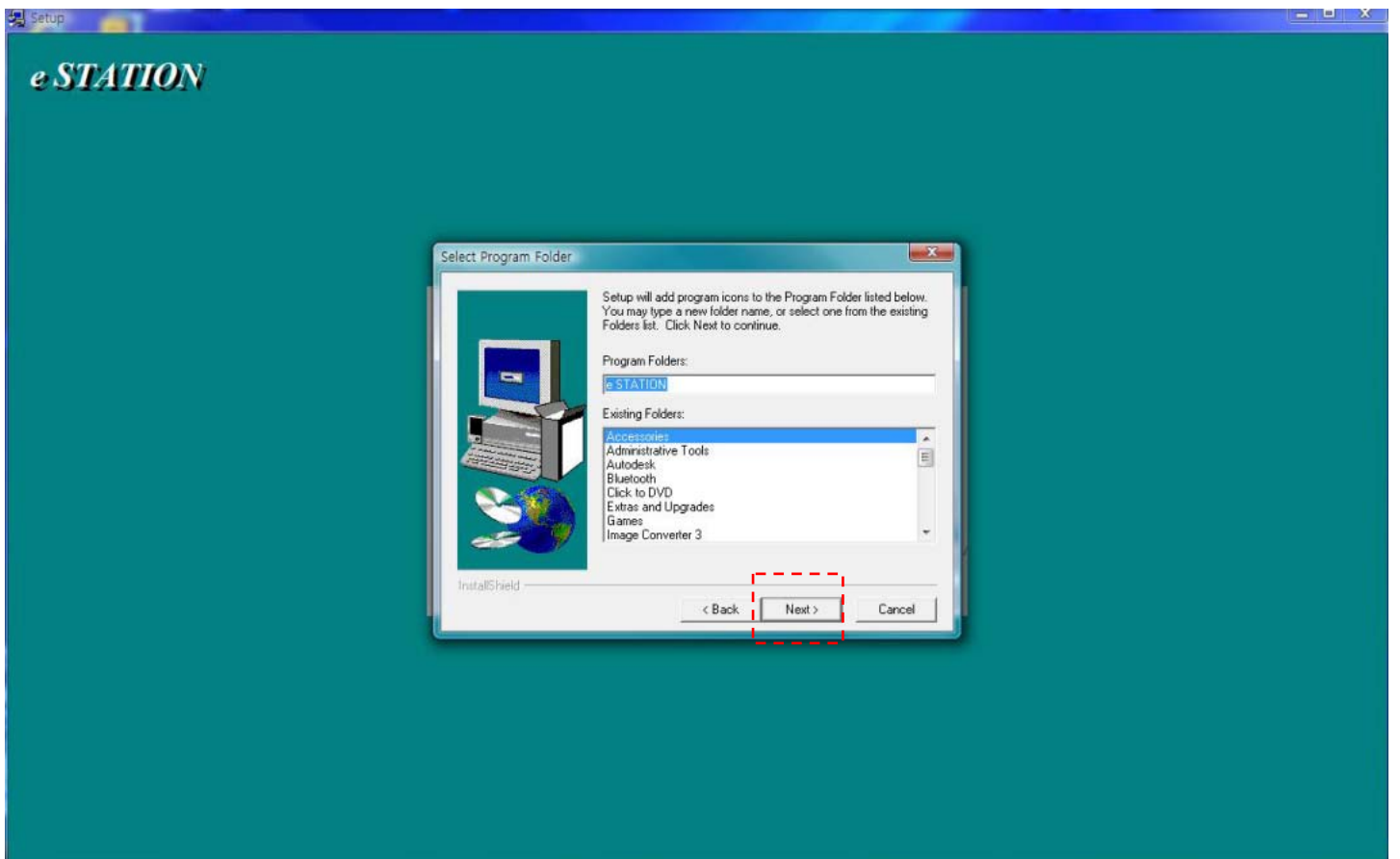
3. Type 'Name' and 'Company'



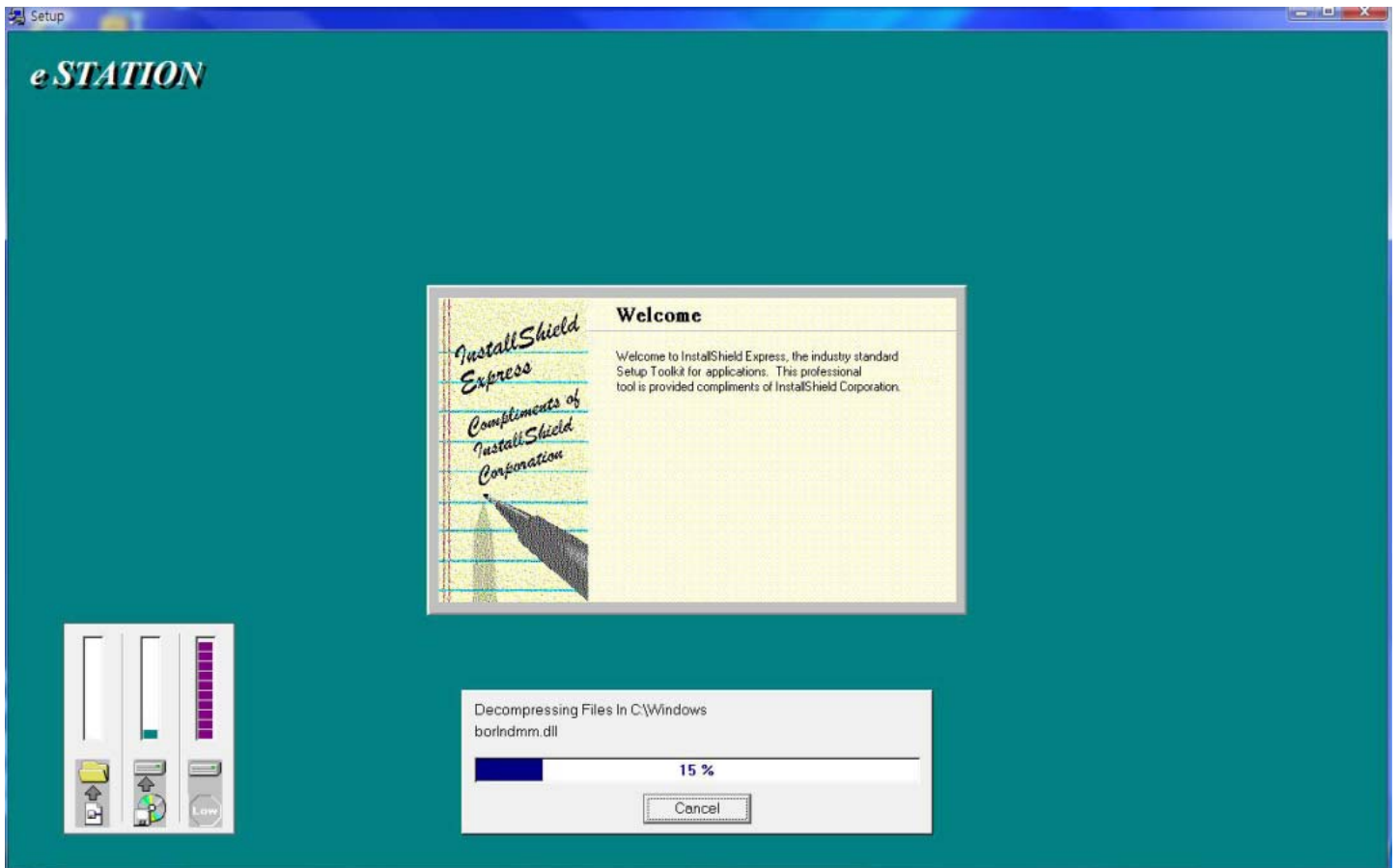
4. Select the destination directory w hich the programw ill be installed. (default path is recommended)



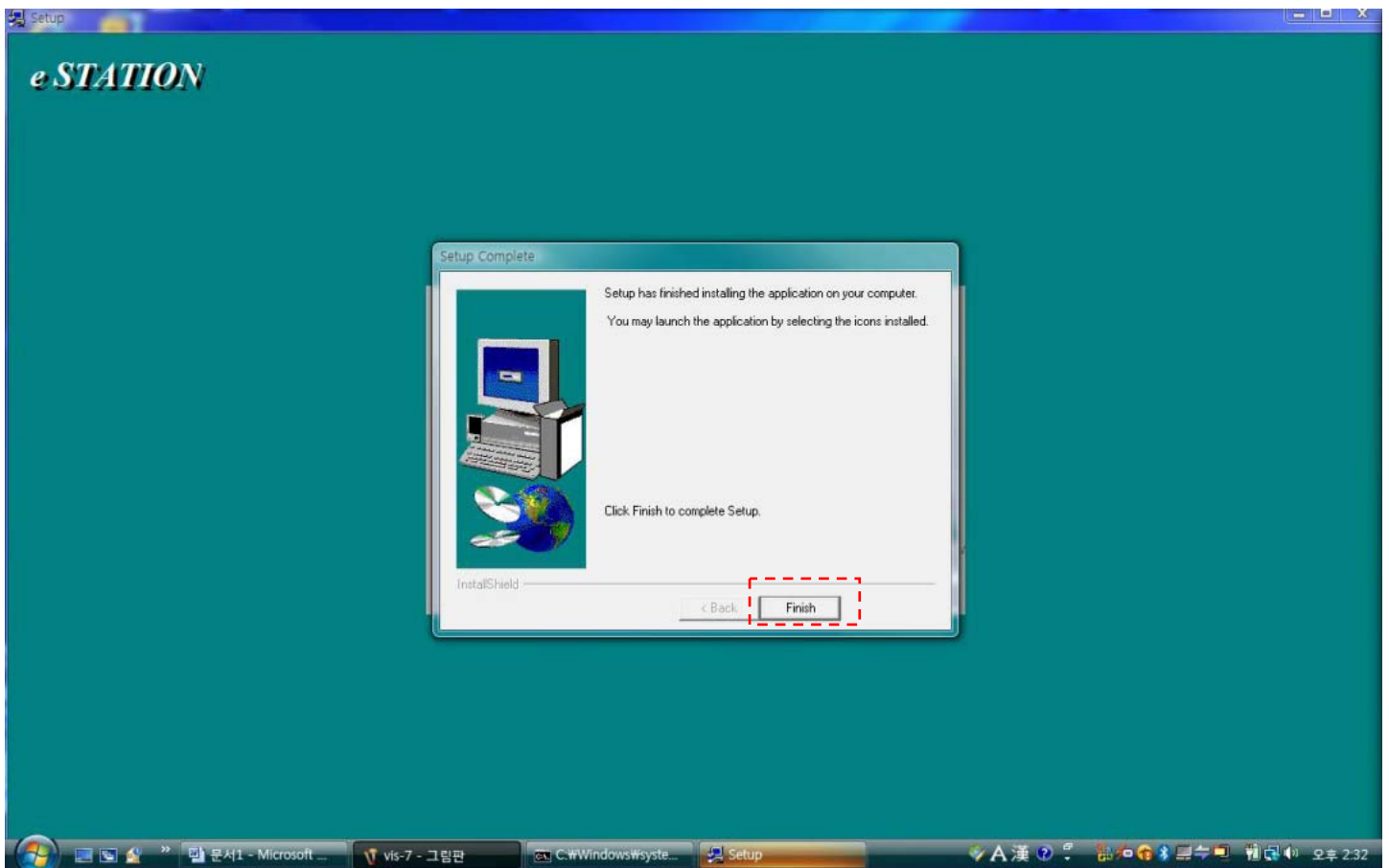

6. Program installation will start.



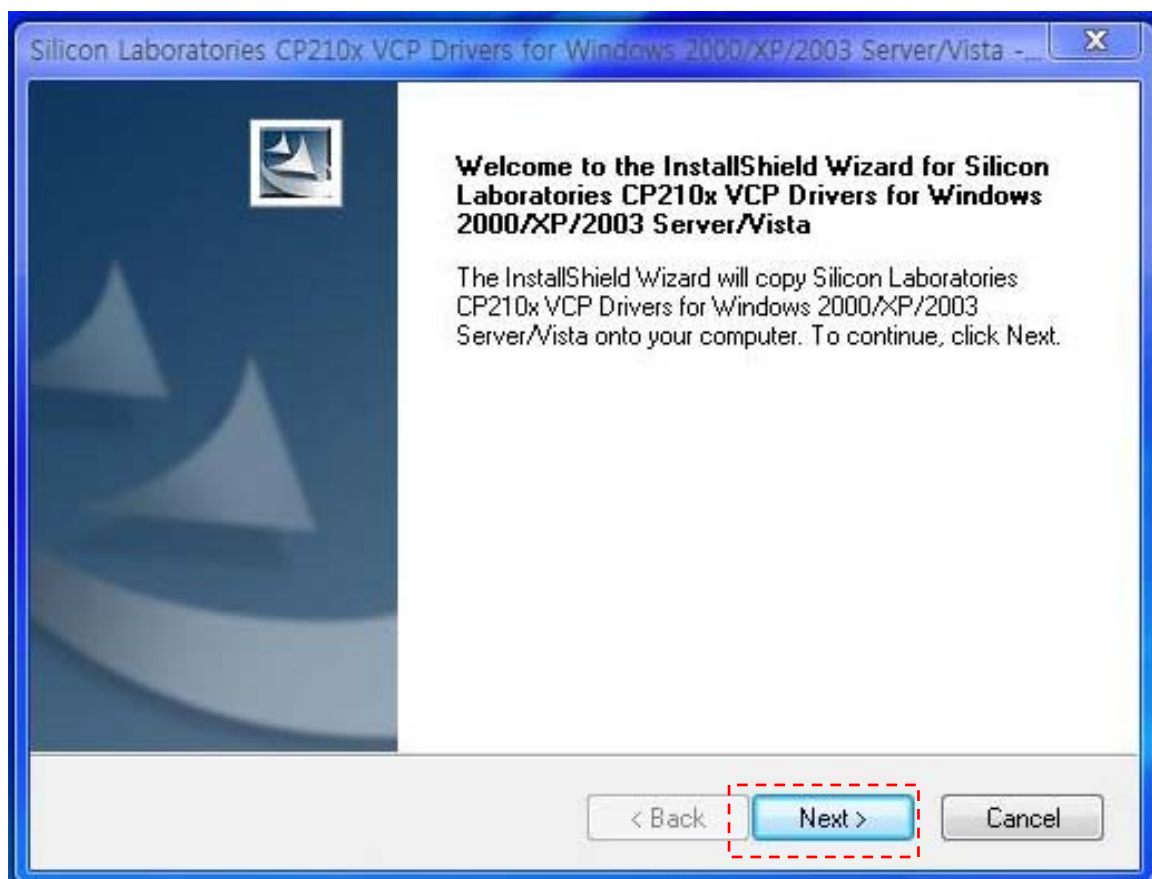
7. When setup has finished, click 'Finish'. This is all of the program installation. Now, the USB driver file will be installed.



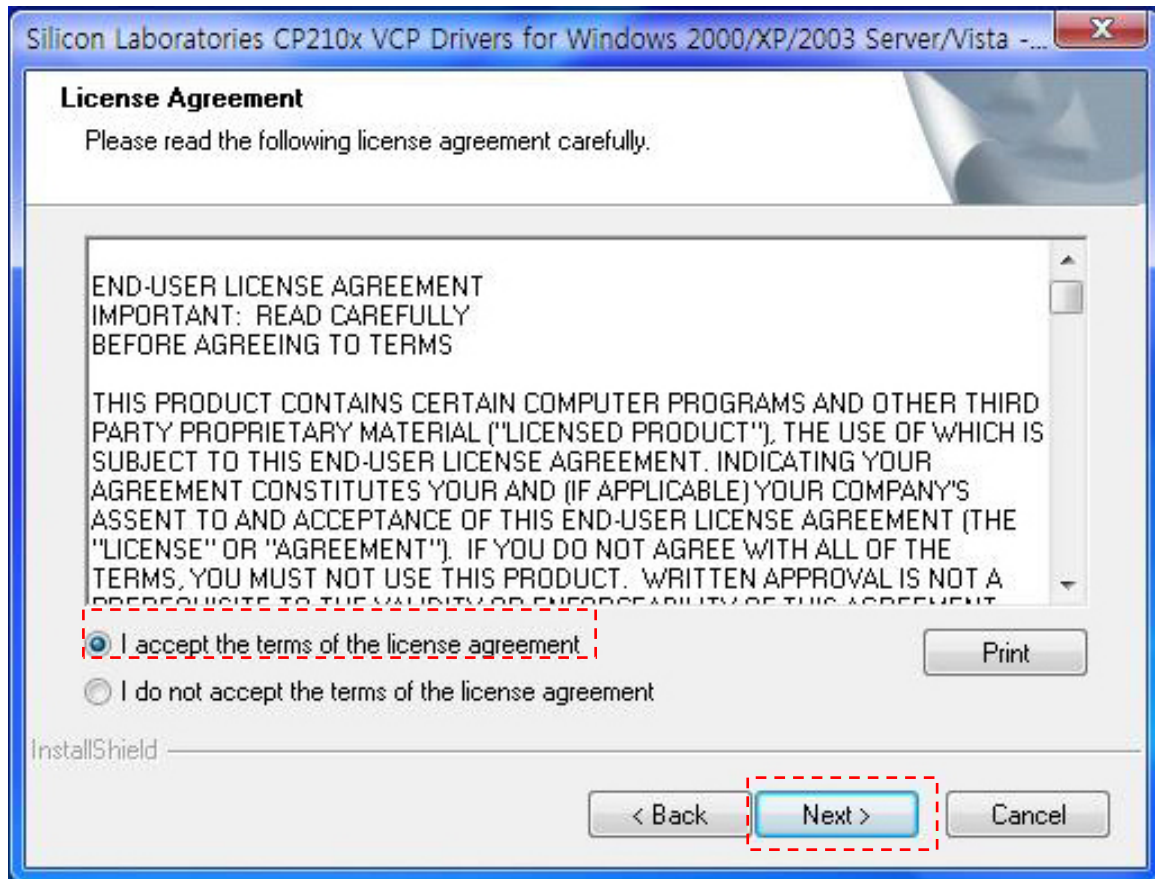
- USB driver files installation



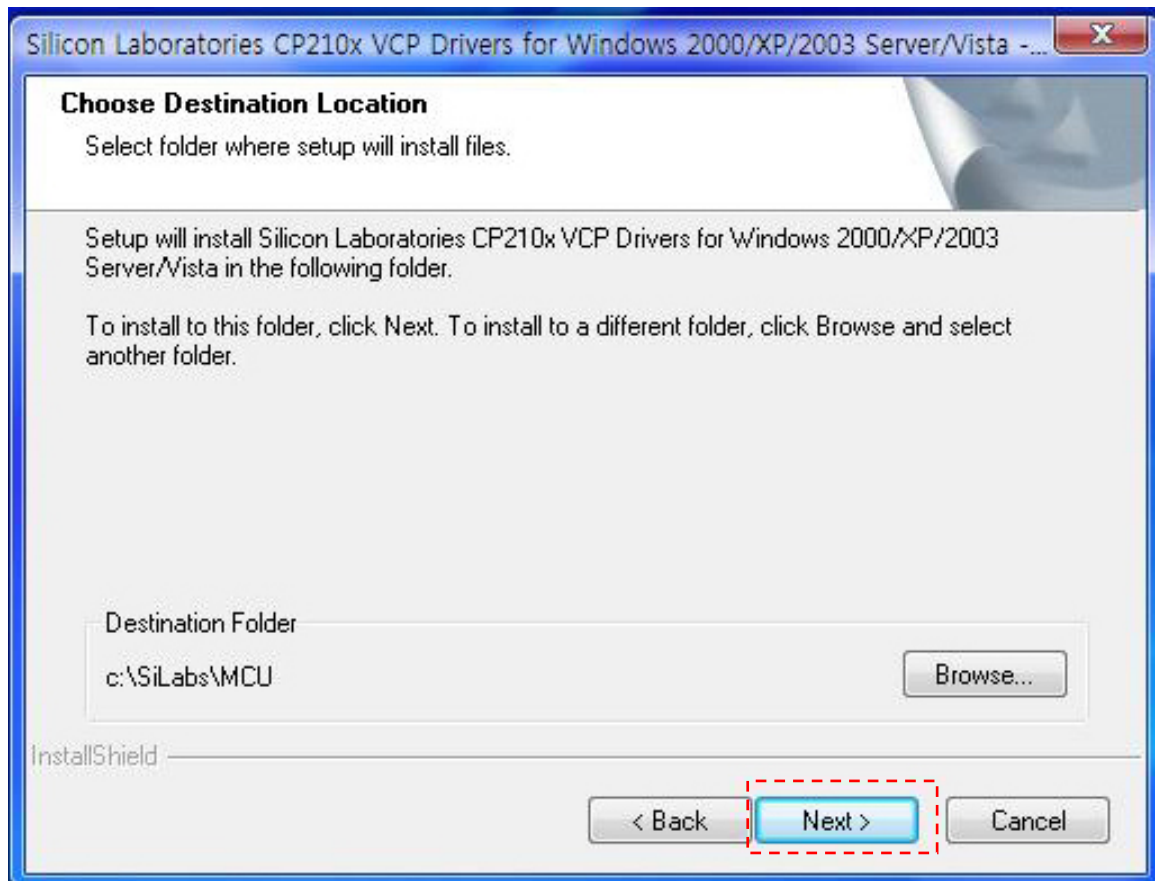
1. Click 'Next'.



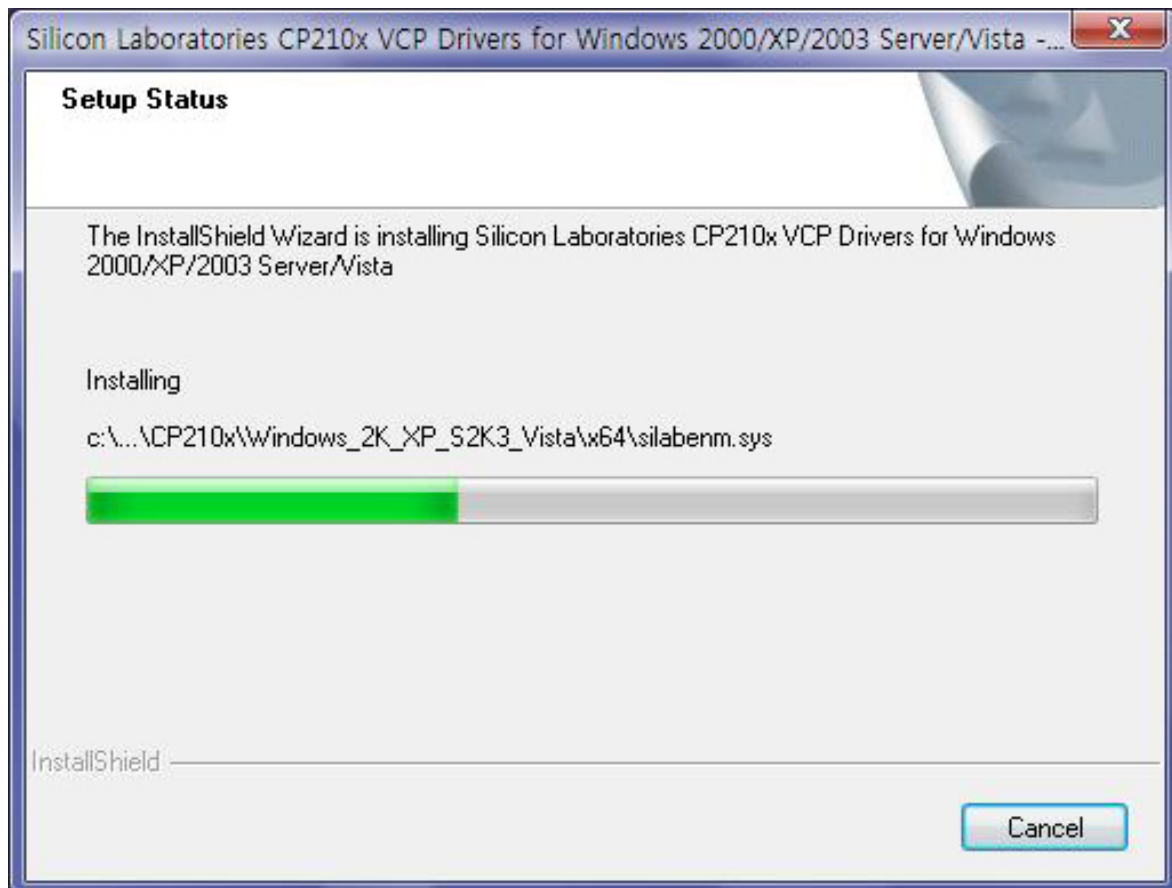
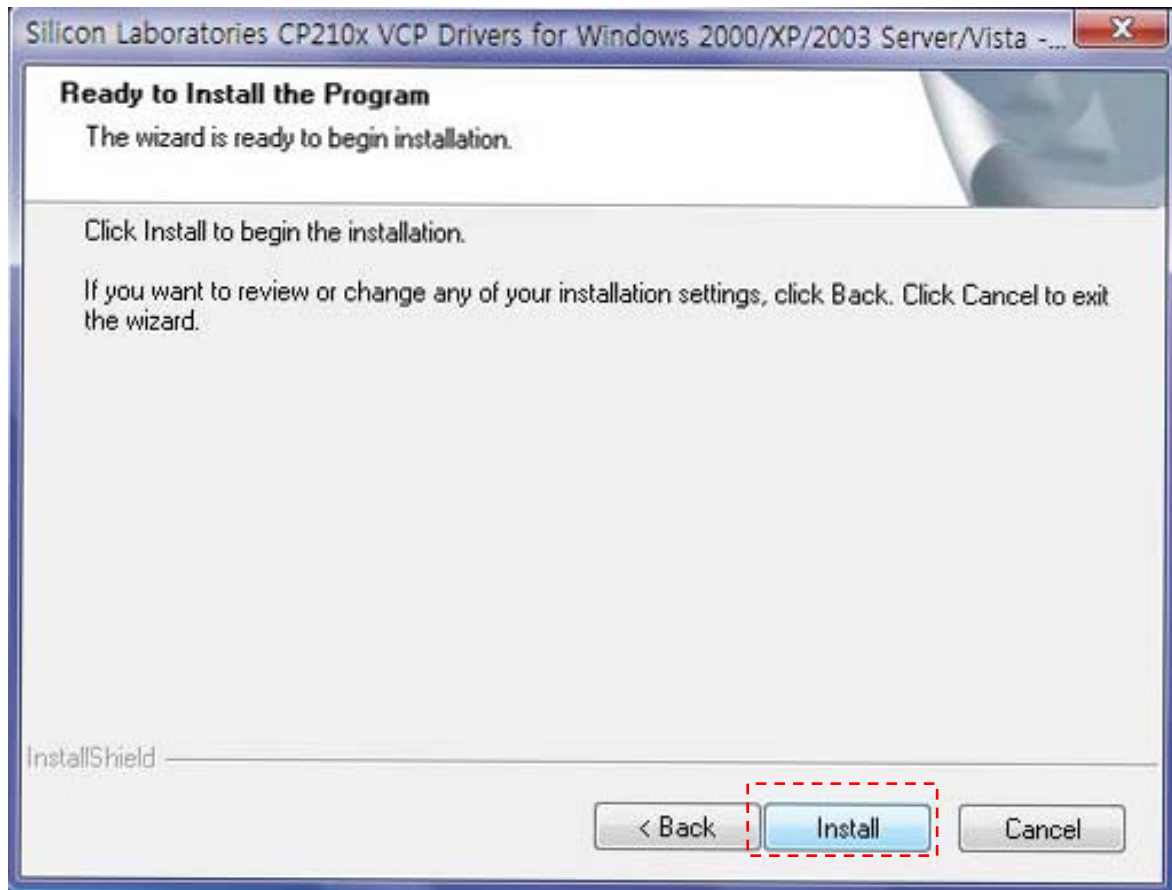
2. Check 'I accept the', and click 'Next'.



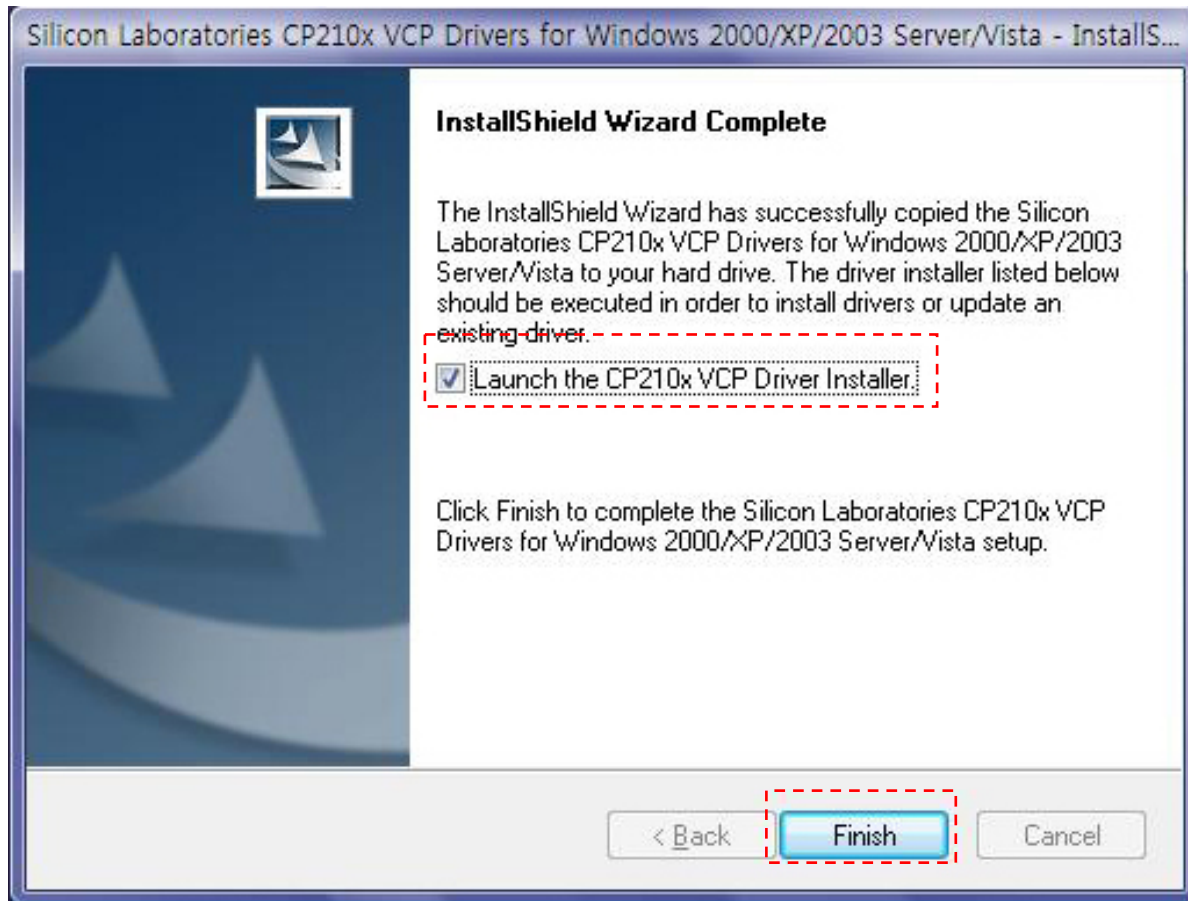
3. Select the destination folder which USB driver is installed. (default path is recommended)



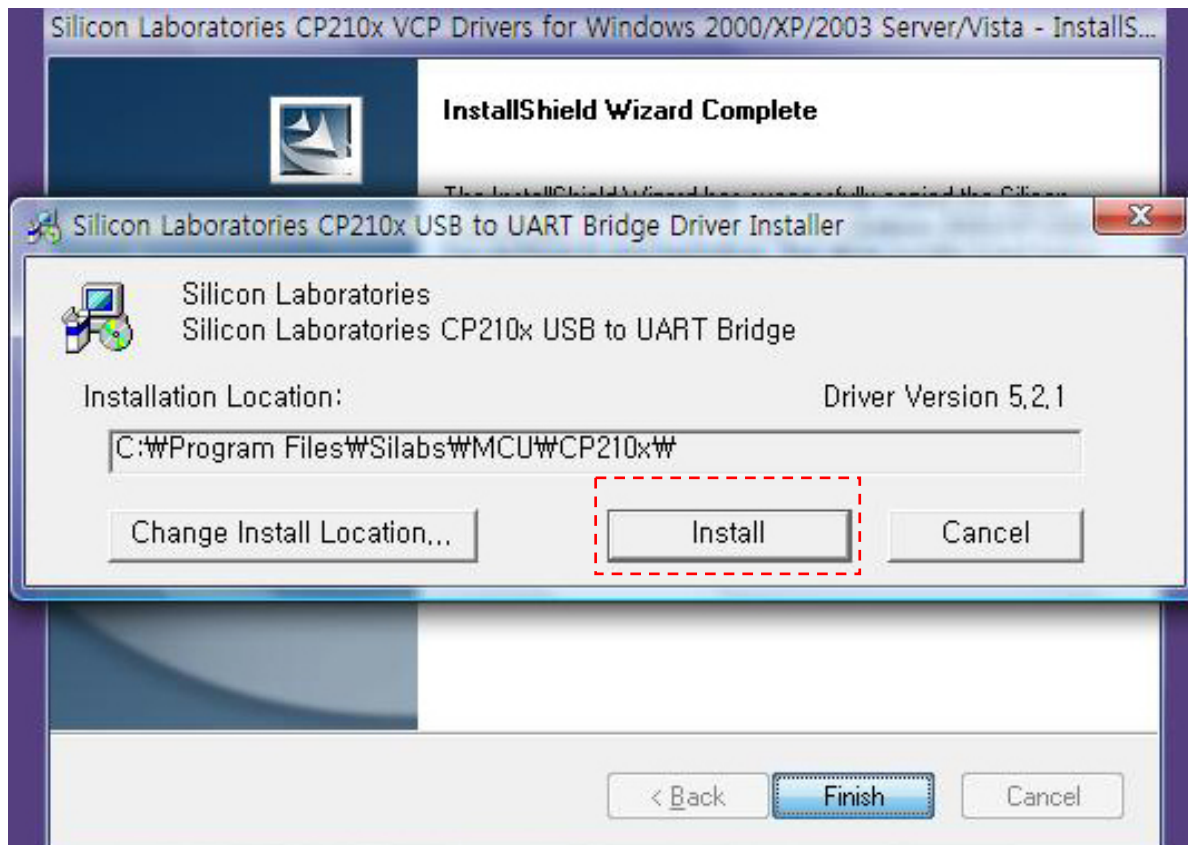
4. Click 'Install' to begin the installation.



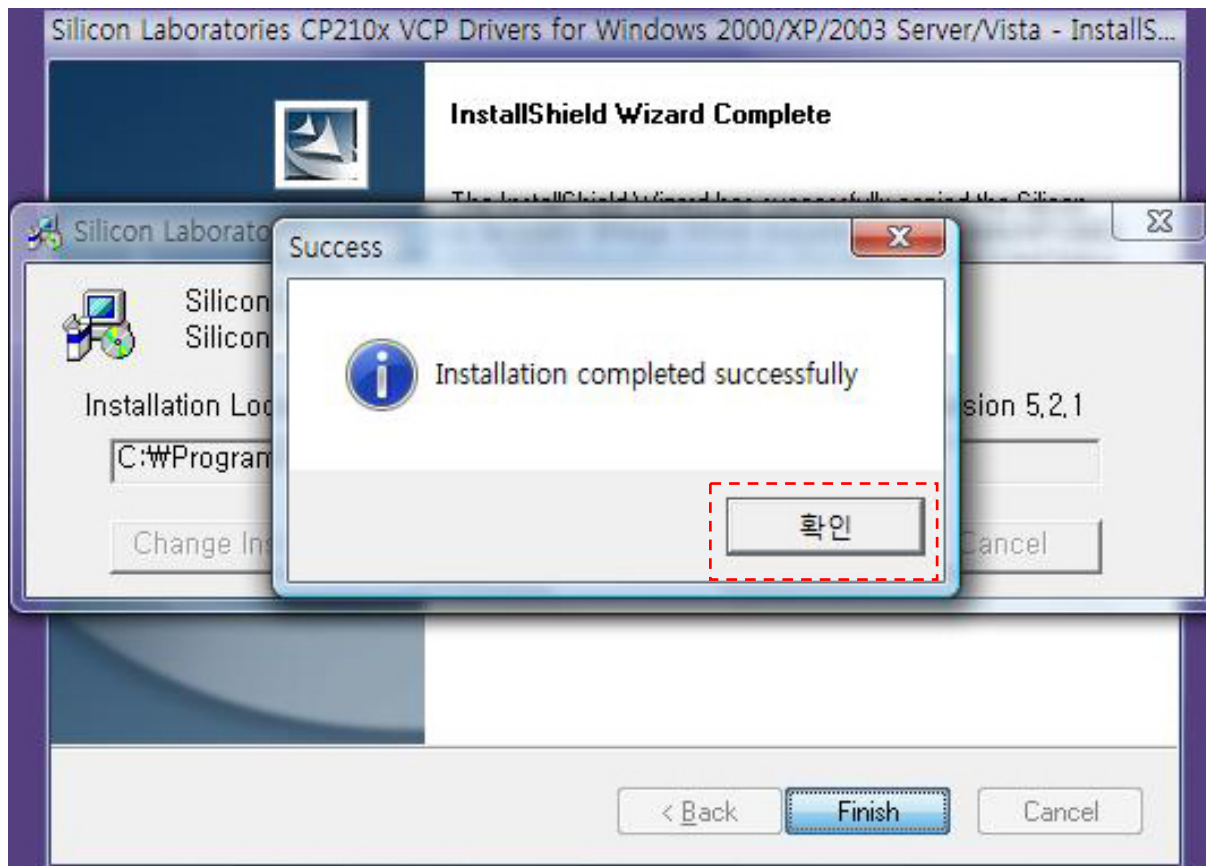
5. Check the box to launch the driver installer, and click 'Finish'.



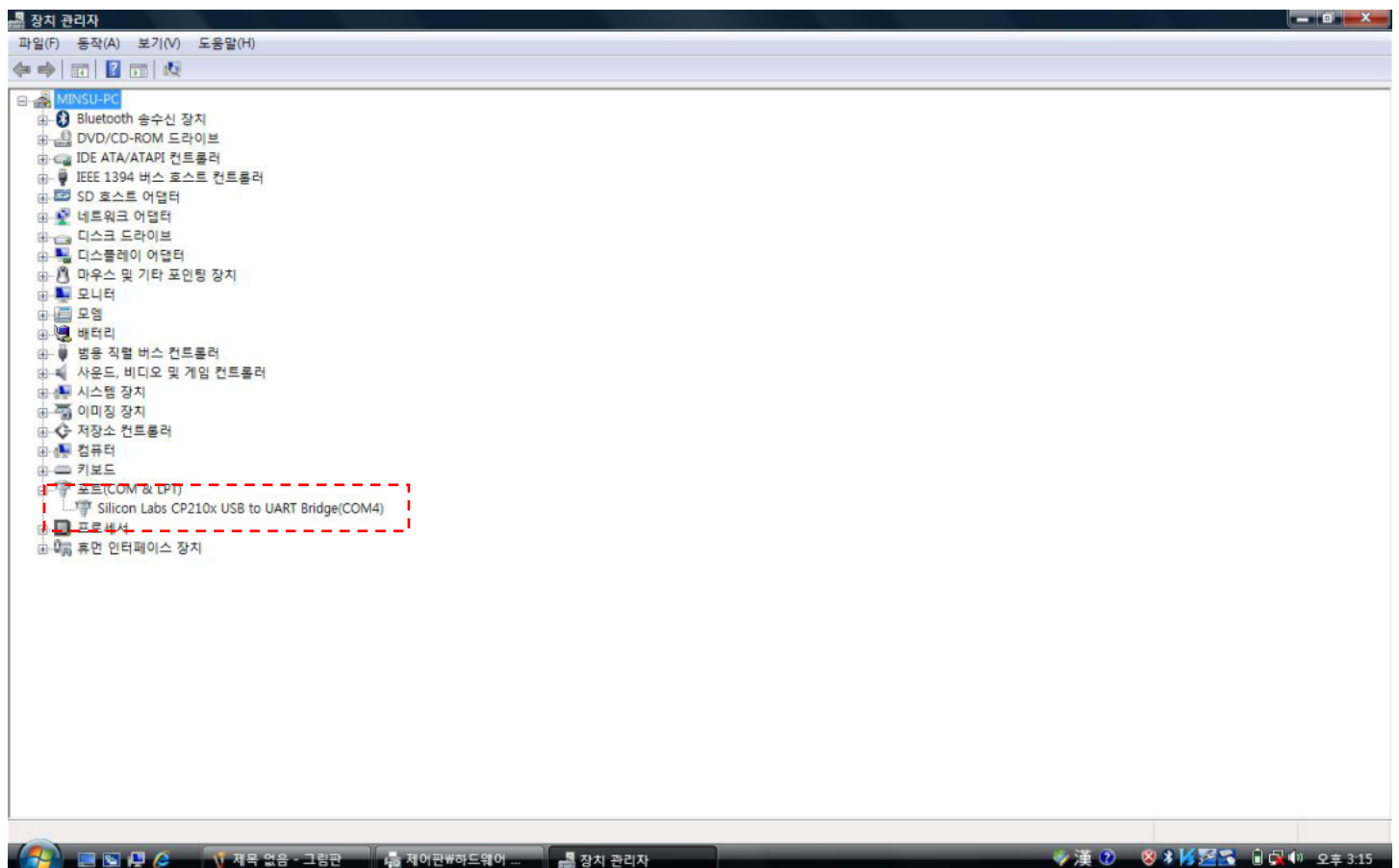
6. Click 'Install'.
